

Small Group Policy

Temporary, during COVID

In anticipation of allowing some small groups to start meeting at the fellowship, the following requirements have been established.

Each group will consist of no more than ten people, including the host/s.

An online option for the meeting/event must be available.

The host/s will have in person attendees register in advance and let the group know when it is full.

The host/s will have attendees sign in at the event/meeting with names and contact info in case of someone testing positive for covid-19.

The host/s will keep this list and be responsible for notifying the Minister if any contact tracing is necessary. The host/s will also be responsible for performing any necessary contact tracing.

If anyone is ill, do not attend. Host/s if you notice anyone appearing ill, do not allow them to attend.

Groups will use guidelines for meeting with unvaccinated individuals. Each person (or family unit) is required to have a minimum of 113 square feet. That space will be maintained at all times.

Masks must be worn by all attendees at all times.

The host/s must spot clean and disinfect before and after the meeting/event. This must include; door handles, bathroom fixtures, toilet handles, tables, and anything else people come into contact with.

The kitchen will be closed, and no food allowed. Attendees can bring their own water bottles.

At this time meetings can only be held in the sanctuary, and meeting host/attendees will be responsible for re-setting up the furniture.
